What you need to do now:

The first thing you need to do is check your calendar - ensure that you are free for the weekend and also make sure that you will be able to attend the store on the Friday before your open water weekend in order to pick up your equipment AND that you are able to bring that equipment back to the store on the first business day after your course.

Now that you have checked your calendar - call the store and book into your course, all the dates we go out to Dutch Springs are listed on the class schedule page of our web site - don't leave it too long as we restrict numbers to ensure student to instructor ratios are low.

Please attend the store during the week before you go to Dutch so we can fit you for your wetsuit, BCD, hood and gloves.

If you have left a long time between part 1 and part 2 of your course you may want to think about booking a refresher session with us to brush up a little on those skills. Call the store if you think this might be something you want to do.

A Diver's Guide To Part Two

Certification

Congratulations on completing part 1 of your Open Water Diver Course - you are now over half way to obtaining the coveted PADI Open Water Diver certification.

In order to obtain your certification you need to complete 4 dives in open water - but don't worry we will not surprise you with any new skills; you will just practice the skills you have already mastered.

You will complete the open water course over a 2 day weekend with us at Dutch Springs in PA, about 1 hour 15 from the store. The cost of part 2 is \$235. The entry fee into Dutch Springs is payable direct to Dutch Springs and is \$36 per day- you also need to purchase two 'Air Fill' tickets so you can refill your tanks overnight at Dutch Springs.

You need to be at Dutch Springs at 7.15am on the Saturday morning. On arrival fill out a liability waiver which can be found on the tables outside the admissions building. When you get into the facility you will be directed to the 'student side', look for the canopy with our banner displayed
