



Wreck Diving Specialty Course



Whether sunk on purpose as an artificial reef or the result of an accident, wrecks open fascinating windows to the past. Most divers find wrecked ships, airplanes and even automobiles nearly irresistible because they're intriguing to explore, exciting avenues of discovery, and usually teeming with aquatic life. The PADI Wreck Diver course teaches you the ins and outs of rewarding, responsible wreck diving.

Course Overview

The course includes four dives that take place over two days. The first day typically is at Dutch Springs and the second day off a charter boat. The course will cover techniques for diving and exploring shipwrecks, how to avoid common hazards, how to research and learn the background of wrecks, use of specialty equipment, and considerations and techniques for entering intact wrecks. Academic discussions take place in between dives at the dive sites.

Requirements

- Prerequisite certification: PADI Advanced Open Water Diver, or have a qualifying certification from another training organization.
- Minimum age requirement: 15 years
- Read and complete knowledge reviews from the Wreck Diving manual



Required Equipment

In addition to the standard diving equipment, you will need to own or rent the following items for the course: surface marker, wreck reel, compass, and pony bottle. These are items that are required when diving in the Northeast.

Costs

Tuition for the class is \$199. Tuition does not include equipment, Wreck Diving Manual, park entrance fees or boat charter fees.
